

### Vadyavisharadan Kochampilli Raman Nambiar (1864 - 1957)

Kochampilli Raman Nambiar was born to Kochampilli Kunhi Nangiyaramma, in Killikkurissimangalam, Lakkidi, Palakkad in 1864. He soon mastered the art of accompanying Koodiyaattam on Mizhavu and also gained proficiency as Soothradharan (narrator) which is an integral role in many plays. He mentored many students, prominent among them being P K Narayanan Nambiar, a stalwart in the present generation. Raman Nambiar passed away in 1957, after a lifetime devoted to his beloved art.



### Vazhenkada Govinda Warrier

(1917 - 2003)

Shri Govinda Warrier was the first chutty (make up) instructor of Kerala Kalamandalam and a pioneer in this crucial but relatively less acknowledged facet of Kathakali. Born in 1917, Govinda Warrier trained under doyen Vazhenkada Rama Warrier and directed many innovations and improvements in the art of Kathakali make up. Govinda Warrier joined the newly established Kerala Kalamandalam in 1939 and contributed enormously to the art form during his tenure till 1978. He passed away in 2003 and his immense contributions have been recognized with several awards including from Kendra Sangeet Natak Academy, the most prestigious government institution in India for performing arts.

### Kalamandalam K Gopalakrishnan

(1951 - 2008)

Kalamandalam Gopalakrishnan was born in 1951 in Vellinezhi, Palakkad a vibrant center of Kathakali. He was soon introduced to the mesmerizing art form by maestro Vellinezhi Nanu Nair. He later joined Kerala Kalamandalam and underwent rigorous training under greats like Kalamandalam Ramankutty Nair and Kalamandalam Padmanabhan Nair. He was soon established as one of the most prominent actors in his generation and was especially noted for the perfection of his movements. He flourished into a great actor and successful teacher and his untimely demise in 2008 while yet to scale his peak was a great loss for Kathakali.



### Kuzhur Kuttappan Marar (1928 - 1991)

Kuttappan Marai was born in 1928 to a family of traditional percussion artistes and started his training at a very young age. He gave his first Thimila performance at the age of 15 and was soon a regular at major temple festivals across Kerala. He was an important performer for the famous Panchavaadyam at Thrissur Pooram for 40 years. Several accolades came his way and the maestro Chottanikkara Narayana Marar was his student. After a life dedicated to art, Kuttappa Marar passed away in 1991.
